Your doctor has now prescribed your prosthesis and we are about to begin our portion of your rehabilitation process.

In order to keep on schedule, keeping appointments is imperative. If you can not keep an appointment please give us at least 24 hours notice, more if possible, so we can use the appointment time for other patients.

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| First Appointment: | Casting and Measurements of your residual limb, discussion of the prescription, and our financial policy. | Approximate time – 1 1/2 hr. |
| Second Appointment: | Check socket fitting. | Approximate time - 1 hr. |
| Third Appointment: | Static and Dynamic Alignment of the prosthesis. | Approximate time - 1 1/2 hr. |
| Fourth Appointment: | Dynamic alignment and further gait analysis. Cosmetic application of Prosthesis. | Approximate time - 1 1/2 hr. |
| Fifth Appointment: | Delivery of Prosthesis:
Hospital Patients .delivered to Clinic or PT session where Rx was issued.
Office Patients .delivered at our office, patient is then responsible to

This schedule is a guide only. Since Hinnant Prosthetics uses the most up to date methods and state of the art equipment, many times we are able to significantly reduce the number of initial visits necessary and still give you the best fit possible.

Please bring tennis shorts or walking shorts to each fitting. Shoe styles and heel heights will be discussed at the first appointment, but please bring the shoes you may wish to wear with your prosthesis to the first visit.

If you have specific questions, it may be helpful to jot them down and bring the list with you so we can discuss them with you. Your input can be very helpful to us in our total prosthetic program.

Please keep us updated of any medical problems or changes to your overall condition. Your physician can advise you if you should make us aware of any medications you use that will affect your prosthetic fit.
